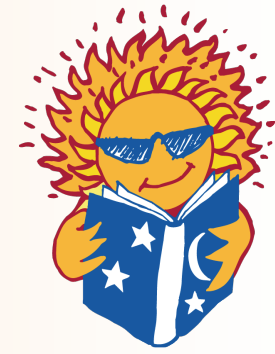

Reinforce Reading & Writing Skills

Daily from 8:15 a.m. until 10:30 a.m.

Students at all levels learn proven strategies to strengthen reading and writing skills.

Young readers will reinforce these skills:

- Word identification
- Decoding
- Vocabulary
- Reading fluency
- Comprehension



Older students will reinforce these skills:

- Inferencing
- Prediction
- Comprehension

All students will engage in the writing process from pre-writing through publication. Exploration of writing through poetry, stories, and narratives will reinforce critical thinking skills as students construct interesting, well-structured paragraphs, essays and stories.

Speech/Language Instruction & Occupational Therapy

Reinforce Math & Problem Solving Skills

Daily from 10:45 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.
